NEW PHOTO ID POLICY

Please remember, the new photo ID policy will be effective at ILC 2019. All competitors will be required to show a photo ID prior to the start of EACH ROUND of their event. A detailed listing of acceptable forms of photo ID can be found at: www.hosa.org/idpolicy . Per the General Rules and Regulations, item #32 A, (<http://www.hosa.org/GRR>) if a competitor fails to show the proper form of photo identification, they will be allowed to compete but will receive a 35-point penalty deducted in Tabulations.
