(2) He/she reviewed the Voting Delegate Packet, and the Executive Council Applicant resumes and videos on the HOSA website.

*Voting Delegates are ineligible to enter competitive events at the VILC – with the following exceptions:*

*Voting Delegates can participate in Recognition Events, including Healthcare Issues Exam (with special testing arrangements submitted by the State Advisor through the Special Activity Registration Form).*

*Voting delegates can compete in up to two (2) National Geographic Learning Academic Testing Center testing events.*

## Tallo

- The deadline for competitors to upload materials, per the guidelines, is **May 15**. Many events will be utilizing pre-judging this year. This means if competitors do not upload to Tallo, there is no content for the judges to score. Ie: If they don't upload their Community Awareness portfolio to Tallo, they will not receive a score for that half of the rubric - they will still be able to present at ILC, but the portfolio piece will not be scored.

## **Registration corrections, additions, or substitutions**

Chapters should NOT email HOSA directly. Only the State Advisor can make corrections, additions, or substitutions to registrations after the May 15 deadline.

## **Outstanding Affiliation Fees and Conference Registration Fees**

All previous outstanding balances such as affiliation fees and State Conference fees must be paid before you may register for ILC.

Conference registration is on Wednesday at 8:00am-11:00am. Please make all efforts to arrive in Nashville in time to pick up your packet.

## **Chapter Registration Process**

Chartered associations should direct chapter advisors to hosa.org for conference registration. Registration is integrated with affiliation; therefore, chapter advisors will login the same way they do for online affiliation. The following steps should be followed to complete the online International Leadership Conference Registration:

- 1.** Go to [www.hosa.org](http://www.hosa.org) and select the Login in the upper right-hand corner and enter your charter number and password.
- 2.** Under the Conferences tab, click on the block for the 2022 International Leadership Conference.
- 3.** To begin registration, click the red Plus Sign (top of page) or the blue Register Members button (bottom of page). To register affiliated members, click the blue Register button to the left of each student/advisor name enter in the correct information and click Save. Follow the process for each conference delegate.

- Be sure to select the correct registration type, options/activities, and competitive event for each student member. Remember members may only register for one competitive event and up to four ATC tests.
- Team Events: To register competitors for a team event, follow these instructions:
  - o Click Register next to the first competitor team member
  - o Select their competitive event from the drop-down list
  - o You will see a box asking for teammate's names - leave this blank - you will link all other teammates to this team member
  - o Click Register for the second competitor team member
  - o Select their competitive event from the drop-down list
  - o In the team member blank put the name of first team member
  - o Repeat this process for each member of the entire team

• **IMPORTANT: When registering members, you must include a valid email and cell phone address that will be accessible in June. If the student will not have access to a school email address, please provide another email address. DO NOT use the advisor's email address.** The email and cell phone number will only be used for competitive events. You must also include a valid mailing address for each student so that any finalist medallions may be shipped directly to the student. We do not recommend using a school mailing address in case mail is not checked over the summer months.

4. To register non-affiliated members (i.e., guests, family members), click the Register Family/Guest button complete the information requested and click save.

5. Chapter advisors may review their registrations at any time by clicking on the 2022 International Leadership Conference. A summary of the registrations is visible on the screen or you may use the Reports button at the to view and print a registration summary and/or invoice.

6. Online registration closes at Midnight (CDT) on May 15. After the deadline, any additions, or changes must be approved by the State Advisor.
