- ☐ Send a letter to parents with event details
- ☐ Provide students with necessary conference information, including cost
- ☐ Discuss dress code requirements with attendees
- ☐ Collect student payment before registration deadline
- ☐ Print copy of chapter's registration and triple check for accuracy before deadline
- ☐ Submit registration and print invoice copy from the HOSA system
- ☐ Submit registration information to bookkeeper for payment
- ☐ Submit payment to Texas HOSA
- ☐ Ensure that all Medical Liability and Code of Conduct forms from students and/or guests have been completed
- ☐ Have Chapter Officers review agenda with attending members
- ☐ Confirm students fill out [Medical Liability, Code of Conduct, Photo Release & Dress Code Policy](#) forms. Print out a copy of all forms to keep with you while you are traveling.
- ☐ Ensure you have [Verification Form printed and signed before check-in](#)
