Area 7 had so much fun at the conference social where they got the opportunity to interact with the officers as well as network with members across the area!

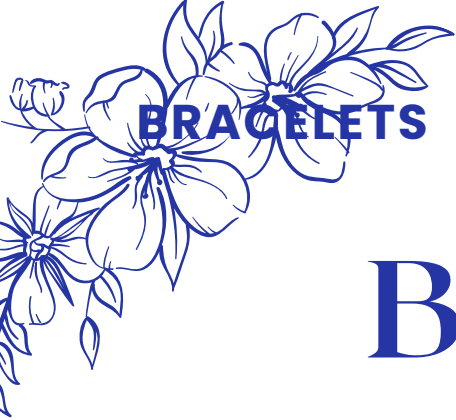
