- Competitors must provide any items listed in the "Competitors Must Provide" box above.

- Debate pairings will be posted outside Competitive Event Headquarters.
  - Teams must report to and remain in the Debate Lounge (holding) until they are called to compete.
  - After the first debate, all teams will remain in the Debate Lounge until the teams advancing to the next bracket are announced.
  - Teams not advancing are then excused from the Debate Lounge and should not return while the event is still running.

#### TEXAS HOSA ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY
