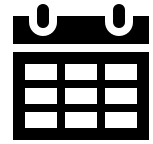




# 2021 Virtual Texas State Conference Extemporaneous Health Poster Middle School



## TIMELINE

- March 3:** 2021 Virtual Texas State Conference Registration Deadline  
Wufoo upload deadline for this event by 11:59 pm CST. (photos of poster)
- March 17:** Conference registration fees due
- March 24:** Virtual Opening Session (see full schedule for the time)
- March 26:** Virtual Grand Awards Session (see full schedule for the time)

- On Thursday, March 4, the Secret Topic will be posted online on [www.texashosa.org](http://www.texashosa.org).
- Competitors will have from March 4 to March 11 to view the topic and develop the poster in response to the topic.
- Competitors will be responsible for providing their own poster board. If it is not possible for the competitor to obtain a poster board, it will be acceptable to use paper size 22" x 28".
- The list of art supplies cannot be checked virtually, but competitors must still follow the rules regarding which art supplies can be used to develop the poster. If a judge questions the use of acceptable art supplies, points may not be awarded.
- Upon completion of the poster, each competitor will submit 1-3 photos of his/her poster. The photos the competitor takes are at his/her discretion and should highlight the poster in the best possible way.
- Competitors will upload their materials to [THIS LINK](#).
- Uploads must be complete by March 11. The uploaded materials are what the judges will use to score competitors.
- If you do not upload your materials, there is no content to be judged, therefore no score will be given. Judges will receive materials on March 11, so if you miss the March 11 upload deadline, your material will not be sent to judges.
- **Pro Tip #1: Do not wait until the last day to upload.** Try to upload your materials before the deadline. If something goes wrong, you have time to troubleshoot!



## **TECHNOLOGY NEEDS**

- Competitors will need to upload their materials to Wufoo – a smartphone, tablet, or computer are needed to upload.
