



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT 2021 VIRTUAL TEXAS HOSA STATE CONFERENCE

How can I make sure the team members are on the same team?

To assure team members are placed on the correct team for competition, you must link team members together. The process is detailed below:

- 1) Register the first competitor for the team event
- 2) Register the second competitor, in the box beside the event that says “Select Team Members,” type the name of the first competitor registered
- 3) The teammates name will populate in the box to link them together
- 4) For events with more than 2 competitors continue the process for each additional team member as detailed above.



Where can I find my invoice for 2021 Virtual Conference Registration?

The invoice will not be automatically emailed to the advisor. HOSA Advisors should log in and print their own invoice. Please see the image below. If more students are added to the initial conference registration, a separate invoice for those added students should be generated by the advisor.

Are there any rules against students who are remote competing in HOSA competitions?

No. Any student who is affiliated with HOSA can participate in competitive events. It does not matter if they are in-person or remote learners.

Are competitors required to take the online tests at school?

No. Online tests can be taken anywhere on a desktop, laptop, tablet, or phone. Tests are open book/open note and competitors should not collaborate with other people. Team members in the team events should not collaborate with each other. Each competitor should take the test on his/her own.

How many students can I register per event for the 2021 virtual conference?

Information can be found in the Advisor Handbook, Section H, page 4-5 or in the chart below.

1. Competitors must be a member of STATE and INTERNATIONAL HOSA to compete in any event.
2. CURRENT Competitive Event Guidelines will be followed for all area and state competitive events.

Each CHAPTER may enter the following number of competitors for AREA conference:

Health Science Events	Four students per event
Health Professions Events	Two students per event
Emergency Preparedness Events	Two students for individual events Two teams per team event
Leadership Events	Two students per event
Teamwork Events	Two teams per event
Recognition Events	Unlimited entries
State Events	Medical Art Poster: Four posters per chapter Blood Drive: One entry per chapter
Officer Candidates	Four candidates per chapter

All chapters may enter unlimited numbers in special needs events at the area level.

CAN A ROUND TWO HOSA BOWL TEAM’S COMPETITION DATE AND TIME ON ZOOM BE CHANGED DUE TO CONFLICTS?

No. To be fair to all teams, the dates, and times for teams to compete on Zoom cannot be changed. Round two of HOSA Bowl is a live, bracketed event and teams must compete at a specific time for the progression through the event to work.
