ROUND ONE

- Competitors will report at the designated time for their written exam
- The Top 10 teams will advance to ROUND TWO
- The 10 finalists will be posted outside Competitive Events Headquarters as soon as the results are available.

FOR THE TEXAS HOSA AREA SPRING LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE, THE COMPETITORS/TEAM WILL PROVIDE

- Photo ID (BOTH ROUNDS)
- Pen or pencil for writing conclusion- ROUND TWO

ROUND TWO COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Competitors/Teams will report to the event room at the time specified on the conference schedule.
- Competitors must provide any items listed in the "Competitors Must Provide" SECTION above.

- <u>DIFFERENCE IN EVENT PROCESS IN TEXAS FROM THE ILC EVENT GUIDELINES</u>
 - Do not bring highlighters as Competitors/Teams will not be allowed to write on the case study documents. Notes should be written on the given index cards.
 - o Competitors/Teams should not bring a laptop/tablet as the conclusions will be handwritten on a given conclusion sheet.
 - A time announcement will be given at the 6 minutes indicating the end of viewing the case analysis and then when there are 15 minutes, 5 minutes, and 1 minute remaining in the 30 minute written conclusion portion of the event.
- There will be a crime scene at the State level of competition.
- Teams will have 6 minutes for Case study analysis and 30 minutes to write their conclusion.
- No competitor should leave until all case studies are accounted for.
- When all papers are collected and accounted for, competitors will be dismissed.

TEXAS HOSA ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

While competitors can have their cell phones, smart watches, etc. with them, they must be in the off
position and stored with their personal items. The competitor may not touch the devices at any time
during the event. There will be consequences for doing so. Be sure to turn off your devices and put
them away before entering the room.
