**For Teachers or Groups:**

The opportunities for your classes are

- 1. Virtual Campus Visit to UT Health San Antonio.** These sessions will be conducted via zoom. ORSO team will help students picture themselves at UTHSA through a pictorial montage of our campus. (30-45 minutes, offered Tuesdays, Thursdays, or Fridays, at time best for your class)
- 2. Overview of Opportunities in the Health Professions.** This presentation will address the career opportunities in the health professions offered at UTHSA and discuss things students should focus on to become competitive applicants for entry into professional programs. (45-60 minutes, offered Tuesdays, Thursdays, or Fridays, at time best for your class)
- 3. Scholar Skills Development Workshops.** These presentations are interactive sessions discussing character traits important in the pursuit of a health profession and in life in general. Topic choices are Gratitude, Empathy, Patience, Importance of Communication, Respect, Trust, Positive Attitude, Leadership and Accountability. (45-60 minutes, offered Tuesdays, Thursdays, or Fridays, at time best for your class)
- 4. Voelcker Biomedical Research Academy Informational Sessions.** These sessions are for classes where freshmen are attendees, given that Voelcker Academy will be returning to a 3-year format this year, requiring that new applicants be freshmen this year. Specific information about the next cohort of Voelcker applicant will be sent in a forthcoming email in a few weeks. The sessions will discuss what the Academy is about, competitive application and answer questions regarding the application process. These 45-60-minute information sessions will be offered on 9/23, 10/7, 10/21, 11/4, 11/18 and 12/2. Please sign up for a time slot that suits your school's schedule.
