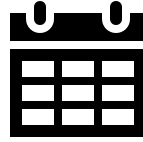




2021 Virtual Texas State Conference Health Career Preparation Middle School

- Some of the content in the all/none section of the rubric was removed such as copies of statement of interest. The wording of the interview section was modified to align with a video presentation of the questions.
- Competitors will submit: 1) Statement of Interest 2) Video of Question Responses.
- All competitors will record a video of themselves answering the four (4) questions listed in item #5 of the event guidelines. These are the same four questions that should be addressed in the Statement of Interest. Pay attention to the modified rubric - in the video presentation, you will be judged on a brief opening to your video, your response to the four questions, a closing to end the video, and your confidence, poise, etc.

- **Videos can be a maximum of 4 minutes in length.**
- Competitors will upload their video to [THIS LINK](#).
- Uploads must be complete by March 3. The uploaded materials are what the judges will use to score competitors.
- If you do not upload your materials, there is no content to be judged, therefore no score will be given. Judges will receive materials on March 3, so if you miss the March 3 upload deadline, your material will not be sent to judges.
- **Pro Tip #1: Do not wait until the last day to upload.** Try to upload your materials before the deadline. If something goes wrong, you have time to troubleshoot!
