COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Competitors will report to the online testing room at the time designated in the conference schedule.
- Competitors must provide a photo ID at check-in.
 - Digital IDs are not accepted. The photo ID must be the actual ID or a signed copy of the HOSA Competitor Identification Form (available on the International HOSA website)
- Competitors will take the online HOSA Voting Delegate Test.

TESTING

- The HOSA Voting Delegate test shall be in the form of a 25-item multiple choice test and one essay question.
- The written test will measure knowledge and understanding of the information required to be a voting delegate.
- Competitors will have 30 minutes to complete the test.
- The essay will only be used if a tiebreaker is needed.
- See guidelines for references and test plan.
- Dress Code for testing: Competitors must be in official HOSA uniform or in proper business attire for testing. Bonus points will be awarded.
