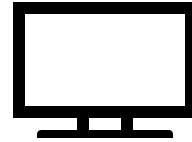
TIMELINE

Tallo upload deadline for this event by 11:59 pm CST (poster)
- March 17:** Conference Registration fees due
- March 24:** Virtual Opening Session (see full schedule for the time)
- March 26:** Virtual Grand Awards Session (see full schedule for the time)

- Competitors will upload a pdf copy of their poster as a single document to the Research Poster event opportunity on Tallo – following the instructions outlined on the [HOSA/Tallo Instructions Page](#).
- **Be sure that the judges can zoom in and read all the information on your poster.** If you can't read it, they won't be able to do so either.
- Uploads must be complete by March 3. The uploaded materials are what the judges will use to score competitors.
- If you do not upload your materials, there is no content to be judged, therefore no score will be given. Judges will receive materials on March 3, so if you miss the March 3 upload deadline, your material will not be sent to the judges.
- **Pro Tip #1: Practice uploading your links to Tallo prior to the March 3 deadline.** You can upload materials to the event opportunity in Tallo, and then delete/edit/re-upload materials up until the March 3 deadline.
- **Pro Tip #2: Do not wait until the last day to upload.** Try to upload your materials before the deadline. If something goes wrong, you have time to troubleshoot!
- **Pro Tip #3: Be sure your pdf file opens.** If judges cannot open the file, they cannot evaluate it. Also, judges should not have to get permission to access your materials.



TECHNOLOGY NEEDS

- Competitors will need to upload their materials to Tallo – a smartphone, tablet, or computer are needed to upload.
