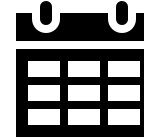

GUIDELINE MODIFICATIONS - TESTING

- The round one test will take place online. Go to **testing.hosa.org** to access the testing system.
- Login credentials will be emailed to local advisors for distribution to students.
- Tests can be taken on a smartphone, tablet, or computer. All tests are open book/open note.
 - Please click [HERE](#) for online testing instructions.
- Tests will be open for a 9-hour window. You can login to test anytime in this window.
- The same time limits will be used for testing, as explained in the original event guidelines (60 minutes, 90 minutes, or 120 minutes).
- The same tiebreaker questions will be administered as explained in the original event guidelines.
- **Medical Terminology and Dental Terminology exceptions:**
 - The tests will be 45 minutes instead of 90 minutes.
 - An additional open-ended essay question will be added to help break ties.
