Due to legal restrictions, it is necessary that all delegates, parents/guardians, chaperones, guests and HOSA Advisors complete this form to be eligible to attend the HOSA International Leadership Conference. When this form is submitted Texas HOSA State advisor will receive a copy. No need to email a copy to Janet Villarreal. A copy of the Medical Liability form and all other required forms must be saved by each advisor for every individual registered for the conference. Every advisor must maintain a copy for each member when traveling to ILC.

All participants competing off-site must maintain a physical or digital signed copy of their liability form on their person.

HOSA has implemented this measure to support emergency protocols and ensure participant safety. This includes event personnel.
